



**LAMBDA EPSILON CHI (LEX)** is the National Paralegal Honor Society. The purpose of LEX is to recognize persons who have demonstrated superior academic performance in an established paralegal program offered at an institution that is an Institutional Member in good standing of the American Association for Paralegal Education (AAFPE).

#### Eligibility of Students for Membership in LEX

1. Membership in LEX is limited to students in good standing at Miramar College.
2. A student may not be eligible for induction into LEX unless the student, at the time of induction, has completed not less than 2/3s of the program requirements to complete their certificate or degree.
3. The student to be inducted must demonstrate “superior academic performance” which is evidenced by a cumulative grade point average 3.5 or higher AND evidence of community service or an essay about their educational experience to make membership in LEX a true and meaningful academic honor.
4. The program director must submit the names and GPA of all qualified applicants to the National Coordinator.
5. Applicants should send their enrollment fee (\$30) and a copy of their transcript to be reviewed to Darrel Harrison.
6. Applications should be submitted no later than March 30<sup>th</sup>.
7. All Inductees are awarded certificates and pins (\$30 enrollment fee) and may also purchase sashes (additional \$30 fee) for their graduation day.
